Why we experiment with the future

Our partners and customers often ask us for assessments of new technologies, trends and business models.

Behind these are usually questions about the strategic orientation of organizations. But how markets develop is only one aspect, the more important question is: How do you make yourself capable of acting in the future?

There is only one way to find answers: experiment, fail, learn, develop. With courageous radical experiments we merge business and design and deliver concrete results as a basis for plausible future scenarios in the digital age.

Approach for future experiments

Together we work out future scenarios and determine how to act in the present in order to move in the direction of the desirable scenarios. A scenario workshop covers steps two and three.


Scenario-workshop schedule

In the scenario workshop it is not our goal to predict the future, but to develop different scenarios. The scenarios provide a basis for discussion. The questions that arise: Which future do we want and how can we help shape it?

Step 1: On the basis of a stocktaking and future trends, a common basis for assumptions and developments is created.

Step 2: In different teams, about 4 future scenarios are developed.

Step 3: The scenarios are discussed and according to the scheme (right figure) arranged.
